Lynda Young, LE: Keeping Colorado beautiful and esthetically educated

In 1994, an ambitious Lynda Young began her esthetics career with electrolysis. Originally from Wisconsin, she was trained and licensed there. She later moved to Colorado and earned an electrolysis certification from the Rocky Mountain College of Electrology. Shortly thereafter, she was also licensed in the state of Colorado.

With an entrepreneurial spirit, Lynda ran her own electrolysis business. Lynda's practice quickly grew and became a success. This business soon flowered into opening her own medical spa: [Rock Creek MediSpa](#). Even though it's nestled in the small city of Superior, the spa attracted a number of consistent clients. Lynda had also added more skills and services to her menu: full-body waxing, eye-lash tinting, airbrush tanning, basic facials, microdermabrasion, and laser hair removal. In fact, Lynda became one of the first full-fledged laser hair removal technicians in the Denver Metro Area. She has owned and operated her own laser since being certified in 1996. The most current laser that she operates is a Lumenis Light Sheer Diode. This particular laser is considered the gold standard in the hair removal industry.

With such a great deal of advanced experience, Lynda decided to provide an electrolysis training program at her spa. She obtained the necessary accreditation and trained students on-site, one-on-one. Because she was one of the few official hair removal specialists in the area, she had the confidence to also train new laser techs. As with electrolysis, Lynda taught and performed services in tandem. Because the incorporation of these two certification programs was fairly smooth, Lynda decided to further expand [Rock Creek MediSpa](#) into a fully-functioning esthetics institute. As such, a well-qualified esthetician/RN was hired to teach. A small-scale skin studies program was created that's both flexible and fairly affordable. This program is primarily home-study, which allows busy applicants to fit it into their schedules. This accredited program ultimately prepares the esthetic student for Colorado State Board testing and licensure,

With so much under her belt, Lynda eventually decided to obtain an esthetician license herself. She sat in on classes while intermittently working on clients. Once she became a licensed esthetician (LE), she began training her estheticians for the boards as well. Somehow Lynda manages to execute these many functions and still maintain her sanity - and even her own good looks! Whether she's in a lab coat or a high-fashion get-up, Lynda always looks the part: clean, conservative, and comfortable..

In order to make Rock Creek all-inclusive, Lynda wisely partnered with reputable, local physicians to provide advanced laser resurfacing treatments, plus Botox injections, and cosmetic fillers such as Juvederm and Restylane, [Only RNs, PAs, and physicians can perform such injections.].

Lynda recently purchased a Hydrafacial treatment machine, which effectively moisturizes all skin types and conditions. This is perhaps the most cutting-edge piece of equipment in the spa setting today. Lynda also works with three of the most current professional product lines in the skin care sphere: [Vivant](#), [Image](#) and [Sanitas](#). She sells daily care products from these companies as well as selling highly-quality Acai juice.

With seventeen years of industry experience, Lynda is likely one of the most resourceful, well-equipped, highly-committed skin care professionals in Colorado (not to mention Wisconsin). Her electrolysis specialization is rather rare and her laser hair removal technique is exceptionally astute. Even in an especially competitive industry, Lynda's business has stayed afloat.
